Ideas to share your faith, or at least think outwardly:

- Attend bar outreach once in the next two months.
- Write out a personal story of God in your life (testimony).
- Share a verse or thought about God on facebook.
- Post a video or send out an e-mail addressing: What I want to say to those I love.
- Pass out a tract per day/week.
- Invite someone to church.
- Start a neighborhood Bible study.
- Start a neighborhood after school program.
- Write a short story explaining some aspect of your faith.
- Invite a neighbor, coworker, or friend over for dinner, a movie, poker night, etc.
- Turn off the radio and pray for coworkers on the way to work.
- Pay for someone's meal or store purchase.
- Learn the names of 12 neighbors and pray for them daily.
- Send a tract in with your bills.
- Ask waiter, phone solicitor, or repairman how you can pray for them.
- Write a note of appreciation.
- Leave a tract with a big tip at a restaurant.
- Give a baggie of goodies to bell ringer, homeless person, teller, or acquaintance.
- Pray before your meal when eating at work or school.
- Keep a Bible out at your workplace and openly read the Proverb of the day during your lunch period.
