Genesis 11:5-6 The LORD said, "If as one people speaking the same language they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them." NIV

Psalm 133:1 How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in <u>unity</u>! NIV

Prov. 6:12-15 A scoundrel and villain...he always <u>stirs up</u> <u>dissension</u>. ¹⁵Therefore disaster will overtake him in an instant; he will suddenly be destroyed—without remedy.

Prov. 6:16-19 There are six things the LORD hates, seven that are detestable to him: ¹⁷haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, ¹⁸a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, ¹⁹a false witness who pours out lies and a man who <u>stirs up</u> <u>dissension</u> among brothers.

Prov. 10:12 Hatred <u>stirs up dissension</u>, but love covers over all wrongs.

Prov. 15:18 A hot-tempered man <u>stirs up dissension</u>, but a patient man calms a quarrel.

Prov. 16:28 A perverse man <u>stirs up dissension</u>, and a gossip separates close friends.

Prov. 28:25 A greedy man <u>stirs up dissension</u>, but he who trusts in the LORD will prosper.

Prov. 29:22-23 An angry man <u>stirs up dissension</u>, and a hot-tempered one commits many sins. ²³A man's pride brings him low, but a man of lowly spirit gains honor.

Ecclesiastes 4:12 Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves. A cord of three strands is not quickly broken.

Rom. 15:5-6 May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a <u>spirit of unity</u> among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, ⁶so that with <u>one heart and</u> <u>mouth</u> you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Rom. 16:17 ... watch out for those who cause <u>divisions</u> and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them.

1 Cor. 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you <u>agree with one another</u> so that there may be <u>no divisions</u> among you and that you may be <u>perfectly united</u> in mind and thought.

1 Cor. 3:3 for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and <u>divisions</u> among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men? NKJ

1 Cor. 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you <u>agree with one another</u> so that there may be <u>no divisions among you</u> and that you may be <u>perfectly united in mind and thought</u>.

1 Cor. 6:1-8...⁴Therefore, if you have disputes about such matters, appoint as judges even men of little account in the church!...⁷The very fact that you have lawsuits among you means you have been completely defeated already. Why not rather be wronged? Why not rather be cheated?...

1 Cor. 11:18 In the first place, I hear that when you come together as a church, there are <u>divisions</u> among you, and to some extent I believe it.

1 Cor. 12:24-25 But God has combined the members of the body and has given greater honor to the parts that lacked it, ²⁵so that there should be <u>no division in the body</u>, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other.

2 Cor. 13:11 ... be of one mind, live in peace...

Eph. 4:3 Make every effort to keep the <u>unity of the Spirit</u> through the bond of peace.
