Suffering Well

Philippians 1:21-30 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²²If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet what shall I choose? I do not know! ²³I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far; ²⁴but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body. ²⁵Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith, ²⁶so that through my being with you again your joy in Christ Jesus will overflow on account of me. ²⁷Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in one spirit, contending as one man for the faith of the gospel ²⁸without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but that you will be saved — and that by God. ²⁹For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for him, ³⁰since you are going through the same struggle you saw I had, and now hear that I still have. (NIV 84)

How can we suffer well?

Unde	rstand that suffering is 2 Corinthians 4:17 For our <u>light and momentary</u> troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. NIV84
	1 Peter 1:6 In this you greatly rejoice, though now <u>for a little while</u> you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. NIV84
	1 Peter 5:10 And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered <u>a little while</u> , will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. NIV84
	Lamentations 3:32 Though he brings grief, he will show compassion, so great is his unfailing love. NIV84
Believ	ve that suffering Philippians 1:29 For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for him,NIV84
	2 Corinthians 4:17 For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. NIV84
	James 1:2-4 Consider it, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, ³ because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. ⁴ Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. NIV84
	James 1:2-3 When all kinds of trials and temptations crowd into your lives my brothers, don't resent them as intruders, but them as! 3Realize that they come to test your faith and to produce in you the quality of endurance. (Phillips)

Example of good that came from suffering in this passage:

Philippians 1:12-30 Now I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel. ¹³As a result, it has become clear throughout the whole palace guard and to everyone else that I am in chains for Christ. ¹⁴Because of my chains, most of the brothers in the Lord have been encouraged to speak the word of God more courageously and fearlessly... ¹⁸... from false motives or true, Christ is preached... what has happened to me will turn out for my deliverance... ²²If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me... ²⁵Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith, ²⁶so that through my being with you again your joy in Christ Jesus will overflow on account of me... ²⁸without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but that you will be saved — and that by God....
