There must have existed, at some time, and at some place or another, a craftsman or several craftsmen, who made [the watch] for the purpose of keeping time; who engineered its construction, and designed its use Every indication of inventive skill, every expression of design, which existed in the watch, exists in nature; with nature exhibiting an even greater level of complexity than the watch, and that in a degree which exceeds all mathematical probability.
