## Jesus' Teaching: Believe

John 6:29 Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent." NIV

#### Jesus the Bread of Life

John 6:25-40 When they found him on the other side of the lake, they asked him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" <sup>26</sup> Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, you are looking for me, not because you saw the signs I performed but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. <sup>27</sup> Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him God the Father has placed his seal of approval."

<sup>28</sup> Then they asked him, "What must we do to do the works God requires?"

<sup>29</sup> Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to <u>believe</u> in the one he has sent."

<sup>30</sup> So they asked him, "What sign then will you give that we may see it and believe you? What will you do? <sup>31</sup> Our ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written: 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.'"

<sup>32</sup> Jesus said to them, "Very truly I tell you, it is not Moses who has given you the bread from heaven, but it is my Father who gives you the true bread from heaven. <sup>33</sup> For the bread of God is the bread that comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."

<sup>34</sup> "Sir," they said, "always give us this bread."

<sup>35</sup> Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty. <sup>36</sup> But as I told you, you have seen me and still you do not believe. <sup>37</sup> All those the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. <sup>38</sup> For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me. <sup>39</sup> And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all those he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. <sup>40</sup> For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and <u>believes</u> in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day." NIV

Romans 4:4-5 When people work, their pay is not given as a gift, but as something earned. <sup>5</sup> But people <u>cannot do</u> <u>any work that will make them right with God</u>. So they must trust in him, who makes even evil people right in his sight. Then God accepts their faith, and that makes them right with him. NCV

Ephesians 2:8-9 I mean that you have been saved by grace through believing. <u>You did not save yourselves</u>; it was a gift from God. <sup>9</sup> It was not the result of your own efforts, so you cannot brag about it. NCV

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. NIV

Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. NIV

Galatians 2:16 Yet we know that a person is made right with God not by following the law, but by <u>trusting</u> in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our <u>faith</u> in Christ Jesus, that we might be made right with God because we <u>trusted</u> in Christ. It is not because we followed the law, because no one can be made right with God by following the law. NCV

John 1:12 "Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God." NIV

John 3:15-16 "that everyone who <u>believes</u> in him may have eternal life. <sup>16</sup> For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever <u>believes</u> in him shall not perish but have eternal life." NIV

John 3:18 "Whoever <u>believes</u> in him is not condemned, but whoever does not <u>believe</u> stands condemned already because he has not <u>believed</u> in the name of God's one and only Son." NIV

John 3:36 "Whoever <u>believes</u> in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him." NIV

John 6:40 "For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and <u>believes</u> in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day." NIV
