FULLY SON | FAVORITE SON Know This Love: 3

Fully son: We are truly his children.

John 1:12-13 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God— ¹³children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God. NIV

Ephesians 5:1-2 Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children ² and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. NIV

1 John 3:1a How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! NIV

What does that mean to us?

Dad gives us safety and security.

Deuteronomy 33:12 About Benjamin he said: "Let the beloved of the LORD rest secure in him, for he shields him all day long, and the one the LORD loves rests between his shoulders." NIV

Dad takes pleasure in us.

Colossians 1:10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God. NIV

Dad is patient with our shortcomings.

Galatians 4:4-5 But when the appropriate time had come, God sent out his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those who were under the law, so that we may be adopted as sons with <u>full</u> rights. NET

The Greek term υἰοθεσία (*huiothesia*) was originally a legal technical term for adoption as a son with <u>full rights of inheritance</u>. Galatians 4:6-7 Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father." ⁷ So you are no longer a slave, but God's child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir. NIV

Favorite son

God chose us.

Romans 8:31b-32 If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? $_{\rm NIV}$

We are loved the same.

John 17:23b [Jesus prayed to the Father,] "May they [who will believe in me] be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me." NIV

Does God love us more? No. But he does love us the same. We (including Jesus) are all his favorites!

Sonship

Deuteronomy 33:12 About Benjamin he said: "Let the beloved of the LORD rest secure in him, for he shields him all day long, and the one the LORD loves rests between his shoulders." NIV

Romans 8:15-17 For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of <u>sonship</u>. And by him we cry, "<u>Abba, Father</u>." ¹⁶The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that <u>we are</u> <u>God's children</u>. ¹⁷Now if <u>we are children</u>, then <u>we are</u> <u>heirs</u> — heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. NIV

Romans 8:29 For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the <u>firstborn among many brothers</u>. NIV

2 Corinthians 6:14-18 Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common?...¹⁶What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people."

¹⁷"Therefore come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you." ¹⁸"I will be a Father to you, and <u>you will be my</u> <u>sons and daughters</u>, says the Lord Almighty." NIV

Galatians 3:26-29 <u>You are all sons of God</u> through faith in Christ Jesus, ²⁷for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. ²⁸There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹If you belong to Christ, then <u>you are Abraham's seed</u>, and <u>heirs</u> according to the promise. NIV

Galatians 4:1-7 What I am saying is that as long as the heir is a child, he is no different from a slave, although he owns the whole estate. ²He is subject to guardians and trustees until the time set by his father. ³So also, when we were children, we were in slavery under the basic principles of the world. ⁴But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, ⁵to redeem those under law, <u>that we might receive</u> <u>the full rights of sons</u>. ⁶Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father." ⁷So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir. $_{\rm NIV}$

Ephesians 1:4-5 For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love ⁵ he predestined us for <u>adoption</u> to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will. NIV

Ephesians 5:1-2 Be imitators of God, therefore, as <u>dearly</u> <u>loved children</u>² and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. NIV

Philippians 2:14-16 Do everything without complaining or arguing, ¹⁵so that you may become blameless and pure, <u>children of God</u> without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe ¹⁶as you hold out the word of life — in order that I may boast on the day of Christ that I did not run or labor for nothing. NIV

Hebrews 2:10-11 In <u>bringing many sons to glory</u>, it was fitting that God, for whom and through whom everything exists, should make the author of their salvation perfect through suffering. ¹¹Both the one who makes men holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. <u>So Jesus is not ashamed to call them</u> <u>brothers</u>. NIV

Hebrews 12:6 "... The Lord disciplines those he loves, and he punishes everyone he accepts <u>as a son</u>." $_{NIV}$

1 John 3:1-2 How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that <u>we should be called children of God!</u> <u>And that is what we are!</u> The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. ²Dear friends, <u>now</u> <u>we are children of God</u>, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when he appears, <u>we shall be like him</u>, for we shall see him as he is. NIV

1 John 3:10 This is how we know who the <u>children of</u> <u>God</u> are and who the children of the devil are: Anyone who does not do what is right is not a child of God; nor is anyone who does not love his brother. NIV

1 John 5:18-20 We know that anyone <u>born of God</u> does not continue to sin; the one who was born of God keeps him safe, and the evil one cannot harm him. ¹⁹We know that <u>we are children of God</u>, and that the whole world is under the control of the evil one. ²⁰We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true — even in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life. NIV

Revelation 21:7 He who overcomes will inherit all this, and I will be his God and <u>he will be my son</u>. NIV
