Sins of commission (the bad we do):

Ecclesiastes 12:14 For God will bring every deed into judgment, including every hidden thing, whether it is good or evil. NIV

Sins of omission (the good we don’t do):

NT specifically forbids: Foolish talk, filthy language, coarse joking, deceit, swindling, lying (falsehood & perjury), obscenity, and slander.
