Matt 5:31-32 "It has been said, 'Anyone who divorces his wife must give her a certificate of divorce.' <sup>32</sup>But I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, causes her to become an adulteress, and anyone who marries the divorced woman commits adultery."

Matt 19:8-9 Jesus replied, "Moses permitted you to divorce your wives because your hearts were hard. But it was not this way from the beginning. <sup>9</sup>I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, and marries another woman commits adultery."

1 Corinthians 7:39 A woman is bound to her husband as long as he lives. But if her husband dies, she is free to marry anyone she wishes, but he must belong to the Lord. NIV

Romans 7:2-3 ...by law a married woman is bound to her husband as long as he is alive, but if her husband dies, she is released from the law of marriage. <sup>3</sup>So then, if she marries another man while her husband is still alive, she is called an adulteress. But if her husband dies, she is released from that law and is not an adulteress, even though she marries another man.

Matt. 19:8-9 Jesus replied, "Moses permitted you to divorce your wives because your hearts were hard. But it was not this way from the beginning. <sup>9</sup>I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, and marries another woman commits adultery."

1 Cor. 7:8-9 Now to the unmarried and the widows I say: It is good for them to stay unmarried, as I am.

<sup>9</sup>But if they cannot control themselves, they should marry, for it is better to marry than to burn with passion. NIV

1 Cor. 7:27-28 Are you bound [married] to a wife? Do not seek to be released [loosed/divorced/free]. Are you released [loosed/unmarried/free] from a wife? Do not seek a wife. <sup>28</sup> But if you marry, you have not sinned; and if a virgin marries, she has not sinned. Yet such will have trouble in this life, and I am trying to spare you. NAS

1 Cor. 7:13-15 And if a woman has a husband who is not a believer and he is willing to live with her, she must not divorce him... <sup>15</sup> But if the unbeliever leaves, let him do so. A believing man or woman is not bound in such circumstances; God has called us to live in peace.

Matt. 19:8-12 Jesus replied, “Moses permitted you to divorce your wives because your hearts were hard. But it was not this way from the beginning. <sup>9</sup> I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, and marries another woman commits adultery.” <sup>10</sup> The disciples said to him, “If this is the situation between a husband and wife, it is better not to marry.” <sup>11</sup> Jesus replied, “Not everyone can accept this word, but only those to whom it has been given.
