\_\_\_\_\_ (doctrine of salvation) (1 John 2:1, 22; 4:2, 10, 15; 5:1, 10-13)

1 John 5:1 Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves the father loves his child as well. NIV

\_\_\_\_\_ (1 John 2:9-11; 3:14; 4:7, 16-17, 19-20)

1 John 4:7 Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. NIV

\_\_\_\_\_ (1 John 1:6; 2:3, 2:17, 29; 3:6-8, 24)

1 John 2:3-4 We know that we have come to know him if we obey his commands. <sup>4</sup>The man who says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in him. NIV

**Spirit** (1 John 3:24; 4:13)

1 John 3:24b And this is how we know that he lives in us: We know it by the Spirit he gave us. NIV

**Abiding** (1 John 2:19, 24, 28)

1 John 2:24-25 See that what you have heard from the beginning remains in you. If it does, you also will remain in the Son and in the Father. <sup>25</sup>And this is what he promised us — even eternal life. NIV

1 John 3:18-20 Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth. <sup>19</sup>This then is how we know that we belong to the truth, and how we set our hearts at rest in his presence <sup>20</sup>whenever our hearts condemn us. For God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything. NIV84

2 Kings 21:1-9 Manasseh ...did evil in the eyes of the LORD...He rebuilt the high places...he also erected altars to Baal and made an Asherah pole...He bowed down to all the starry hosts and worshiped them...He built altars in the temple of the LORD...He sacrificed his own son in the fire, practiced sorcery and divination, and consulted mediums and spiritists. He did much evil in the eyes of the LORD, provoking him to anger...

2 Chronicles 33:12-13 In [Manasseh's] distress he sought the favor of the LORD his God and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers. <sup>13</sup>And when he prayed to him, the LORD was moved by his entreaty and listened to his plea; so he brought him back to Jerusalem and to his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD is God. NIV

Romans 5:1-2 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup>through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God. NIV

Romans 5:6-11 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. <sup>7</sup>Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, though for a good man someone might possibly dare to die. <sup>8</sup>But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

<sup>9</sup>Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! <sup>10</sup>For if, when we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life! <sup>11</sup>Not only is this so, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation. NIV
