Praying for Each Other

Some truths about prayer from Colossians:

Colossians 1:3-4 We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all God's people—

Colossians 1:9-10 For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord ...

Thankfulness should well up in our prayers

Use Paul's prayer as a model to pray for others:

Colossians 1:9-14 For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to:

fill you with the knowledge of his will

through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, so that you may *live a life worthy of the Lord* and please him in every way:

- bearing fruit in every good work,
- growing in the knowledge of God,
- being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience,
- and giving joyful thanks to the Father,
 - who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light.
 - For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,
 - in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

(Some other prayer models: Eph 1:15-20, Eph 3:14-19, Phil 1:9-11, 1 Thess 3:10-13, 5:23-25; 2 Thess 1:11-12)
