

What is love?



The extent of God's love is exemplified in Jesus' sacrifice.

1 John 3:16 This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us...

1 John 4:9-10 This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. ¹⁰ This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

The definition of God's love is <u>radically different</u> than typical human love.

Regular definition: Love is an <u>emotion</u> that... Love is a <u>feeling</u>...

Working definition: Love is <u>choice</u> of affection, kindness, and mercy that <u>flows</u> from the heart of the lover and a deep <u>relational</u> connection with the beloved.

God's love is a choice.

John 13:5,11 After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him... ¹¹ For he knew who was going to betray him, and that was why he said not every one was clean.

Romans 5:6-8 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. ⁷ Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. ⁸ But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

God's love is an outflow, not a response.

1 John 4:8 Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.

1 John 4:16 And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them.

God's love is relational.

Genesis 1:27 So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.

Genesis 5:3 When Adam had lived 130 years, he had a son in his own likeness, in his own image; and he named him Seth.

Luke 15:20-24 "But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.

²¹ "The son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'

²² "But the father said to his servants, 'Quick! Bring the best robe and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. ²³ Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate. ²⁴ For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate.

God wants us to love in the same way.
