Drawing Strength from God - Loyal and Sacrificial Friendship

Main Passages about Jonathan:

- 1 Samuel 18-20 – Jonathan and David covenant and friendship
- 1 Samuel 23:15-18 – Jonathan goes to David and helps him find strength in God
- 1 Samuel 31:2 and 1 Chronicles 10:2 – Jonathan's death
- 2 Samuel 1:17-27 – David's lament for Saul and Jonathan
- 2 Samuel 9:1-13 – David's covenant promise to Jonathan

Jonathan and David:

- 1 Samuel 18:1-4
- 1 Samuel 19-20
- 1 Samuel 23:15-18

Main Takeaway:

We will not have the same deep, loyal, and sacrificial friendship that Jonathan and David had if we aren't fighting the same battle and helping each other find strength in God!

- Help people to find strength in God.
- Have God be the center of all of your meaningful relationships.

A lasting friendship is loyal and sacrificial.
