Avoiding Implosion Trajectory Lessons from David and Bathsheba

2 Samuel 11:1 In the spring, at the time when kings go off to war, David sent Joab out with the king's men and the whole Israelite army... But David remained in Jerusalem.

Stay engaged in your mission.

1 Timothy 6:11 But you, man of God, flee from [the love of money], and <u>pursue</u> righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness. NIV

1 Peter 5:8 Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. NIV

Don't get separated from your support system.

Proverbs 18:24 One who has unreliable friends soon comes to ruin, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother. NIV

Set a <u>trajectory aligned</u> with who you are and who you want to be.

Romans 13:13-14 Let us behave decently, as in the daytime, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and debauchery... ¹⁴ Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the flesh. NIV

Steer your trajectory with disciplines, habits, and choices.

2 Samuel 11:2 One evening David got up from his bed and walked around on the roof of the palace. From the roof he saw a woman bathing. The woman was very beautiful,

Take the <u>door</u> out while you still <u>want</u> it.

1 Corinthians 10:12-13 So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall! ¹³ No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

<u>Run</u>!

James 4:7 Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. NIV

2 Timothy 2:22 Flee the evil desires of youth and pursue... NIV

1 Corinthians 6:18a Flee from sexual immorality. NIV

Make tough choices to stay on trajectory.

Job 31:1 "I made a covenant with my eyes not to look lustfully at a young woman." NIV

Proverbs 4:25 Let your eyes look straight ahead; fix your gaze directly before you. NIV

2 Samuel 11:3a and David sent someone to find out about her.

Proverbs 22:3 The prudent see danger and take refuge, but the simple keep going and pay the penalty.

Make <u>tough</u> choices to stay on trajectory.

Realize that the <u>death spiral</u> is easier to <u>enter</u> than <u>exit</u>.

2 Samuel 11:3b The man said, "She is Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam and the wife of Uriah the Hittite."

Don't expect to be <u>rational</u> in the throes of temptation.

Jeremiah 17:9; 1 Timothy 6:9; Romans 1:21

Ephesians 4:17-19 So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the <u>futility of their thinking</u>. ¹⁸ They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. ¹⁹ Having lost all sensitivity, they have <u>given themselves over to sensuality</u> so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed [NIV84: with a continual lust for more]. NIV

2 Samuel 11:4a Then David sent messengers to get her.

Don't depend on <u>others</u> to stop you.

Proverbs 15:22 Plans fail for lack of counsel, but with many advisers they succeed.

2 Samuel 11:4b She came to him, and he slept with her. (Now she was purifying herself from her monthly uncleanness.)

Meet legitimate needs in <u>legitimate ways</u>.

Proverbs 5:18 Rejoice in the wife of your youth. ¹⁹ A loving doe, a graceful deer—may her breasts satisfy you always, may you ever be intoxicated with her love.

2 Samuel 11:4c-5 Then she went back home. ⁵ The woman conceived and sent word to David, saying, "<u>I am</u> pregnant."

Don't be shocked when your <u>desires</u> give birth to <u>sin</u>.

Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.

James 1:14-15 ... Each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. ¹⁵ Then, after desire has <u>conceived</u>, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death. NIV
