WALK IN LOVE HIGH CALLING DISCIPLESHIP 6

Jesus' Teaching: Walk in Love

2 John 5b-6 I ask that we love one another. ⁶ And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands. As you have heard from the beginning, his command is that you walk in love. NIV

God treats his enemies with love and calls us to do the same.

Matthew 5:43-47 "You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' ⁴⁴ But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ that you may be children of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. ⁴⁶ If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? ⁴⁷ And if you greet only your own people, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that? NIV

God treated <u>us</u> with love when we were his enemies.

Colossians 1:21-22 Once you were alienated from God and were <u>enemies</u> in your minds because of your evil behavior. ²² But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation. NIV

Romans 5:8,10 But God demonstrates his own <u>love</u> for us in this: While we were still <u>sinners</u>, Christ died for us...¹⁰ For if, while we were God's <u>enemies</u>, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life! NIV

1 Timothy 1:15-16 Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save <u>sinners</u>—of whom I am the worst. ¹⁶ But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the <u>worst of sinners</u>, Christ Jesus might display his immense patience <u>as an example for those who would believe</u> in him and receive eternal life. NIV

John 3:16 For God so <u>loved</u> the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. NIV

There is something <u>special</u> about all people.

Genesis 1:26-27 Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our <u>image</u>, in our <u>likeness</u>... ²⁷ So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. NIV

Genesis 5:3 When Adam had lived 130 years, he had a son in his own <u>likeness</u>, in his own <u>image</u>; and he named him Seth. NIV

Genesis 9:6 "Whoever sheds human blood, by humans shall their blood be shed; for in the <u>image</u> of God has God made mankind." NIV
