HIGH CALLING DISCIPLESHIP 11

Jesus' Teaching: Fish

Matthew 4:18-20 As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. ¹⁹“Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.” ²⁰ At once they left their nets and followed him. NIV
(Also Mark 1:17)

Matthew 28:18-20 Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” NIV

Mark 13:10 [Jesus said,] “And the gospel must first be preached to all nations.” NIV

Mark 16:15 [Jesus] said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation.” NIV

Luke 24:46-47 [Jesus] told them, “This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, ⁴⁷and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.” NIV

John 20:21 Again Jesus said, “Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.” NIV

Acts 1:8 [Jesus said,] “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” NIV

This is a significant part of our calling.

We need to respond to this mission!

Think of it as Jesus' mission that he gives and supports us in.

Luke 6:46 [Before talking about the wise and foolish builder, Jesus said,]
“Why do you call me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not do what I say?” NIV

Think of it as basic discipleship, not elite-level spiritual nirvana.

Luke 17:7-10 “Suppose one of you has a servant plowing or looking after the sheep. Will he say to the servant when he comes in from the field, ‘Come along now and sit down to eat’? ⁸ Won’t he rather say, ‘Prepare my supper, get yourself ready and wait on me while I eat and drink; after that you may eat and drink’? ⁹ Will he thank the servant because he did what he was told to do? ¹⁰ So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, ‘We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty.’” NIV

Don’t push back on God what he entrusted to you.

A few ideas:

- Intentionally pray for gospel opportunities. (Or pray for the courage to be willing to pray for gospel opportunities.)
- Have a neighborhood barbeque or ice cream social to meet people.
