The Royal Priesthood

- What is a Priest?
 - Someone who is authorized to preform sacred rites especially as a mediatory agent (<u>Representative</u>) between humans and God [often in a temple or sacred space].
- The LORD established a priesthood from the **<u>Beginning</u>**
 - Adam and Eve
 - Were designed to <u>represent</u> the LORD to all Creation and to <u>work</u> (rule) in fellowship and relationship with Him (Genesis 1:26) in a <u>Sacred Space</u> (The Garden of Eden).
 - Told to be Fruitful and Multiply
 - The Covenants (Agreements)
 - Noah (Genesis 8:20 9:17)
 - Abraham (<u>Gen. 17:9-14)</u>
 - Israel / Moses (Exodus 19:3–6, Exodus 24)
 - King David (2 Samuel 7)
 - Humans are **<u>bad</u>** covenant partners
 - Noah (Genesis 9:20-24)
 - Abraham (Genesis 21:8-20)
 - Israel (Most of the Old Testament)
 - David (2 Samuel 11)
- We need a <u>New Human</u> to enter a <u>New Covenant</u> relationship with the LORD on our behalf.
 - o Jesus
 - Comes as a new kind of Human (1 Corinthians 15:45-48, John 1:1-5, Colossians 2:9)
 - Fulfills the Requirements of the Old Covenant
 - Brought in the ultimate atoning (redemptive) sacrifice (1 John 2:2)
 - Is now seated as the High Priest, mediating between us and the LORD (Hebrews 4:14, Hebrews 12:24).
 - We are now:
 - Transformed into new People like Christ (<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u>)
 - A new Royal Priesthood. (Revelation 1:6 / 1 Peter 2:9)
 - The New Temple (1 Corinthians 3:16)
