Create an atmosphere of awesomeness.

Be a great <u>example</u>.

1 Timothy 4:11-12 Command and teach these things. ¹²Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity. NIV

2 Peter 1:5-8 For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; ⁶and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; ⁷and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. ⁸For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. NIV

Cultivate peace for a pleasant home life.

Hebrews 12:11 No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a <u>harvest of righteousness and peace</u> for those who have been trained by it. NIV

Distraction does not cultivate peace.

It postpones the <u>mayhem</u>.

Order brings peace.

Boundaries bring peace.

Discipline brings peace.

Foster relationships with your kids.

Colossians 3:12-14 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ¹³Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. ¹⁴And over all these virtues put on <u>love</u>, <u>which binds</u> them all together in perfect unity. NIV

Make sibling relationships a top priority.

Mark 12:31 "The second [most important commandment] is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."
