- 71% of high school dropouts
- 75% of teens in chemical abuse centers
- 80% of rapists
- 85% of behavioral disorders
- 85% of youth in prisons
- 90% of runaways

## Parenting is not just for <u>women</u>. God has made you the <u>head</u> of the <u>family</u> and holds you <u>responsible</u>.

# Men want to be <u>called</u> to something <u>great</u>. This is something <u>great</u> that you are already <u>called</u> to. <u>Step up</u> and be the family manager.

1 Timothy 3:4-5 [An overseer] must <u>manage</u> his own family well and see that his children obey him with proper respect. <sup>5</sup>(If anyone does not know how to <u>manage</u> his own family, how can he take care of God's church?) NIV84

Ephesians 6:4 Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord. NIV84

### Practical ways to lead out:

### Manage your life such that you are home a lot.

John 16:24 Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete. NIV

### Help your wife be at home as much as possible.

Titus 2:3-5 Likewise, teach the older women to be reverent in the way they live, not to be slanderers or addicted to much wine, but to teach what is good. <sup>4</sup>Then they can train the younger women to love their husbands and children, <sup>5</sup>to be self-controlled and pure, to be <u>busy at home</u>, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God. NIV
