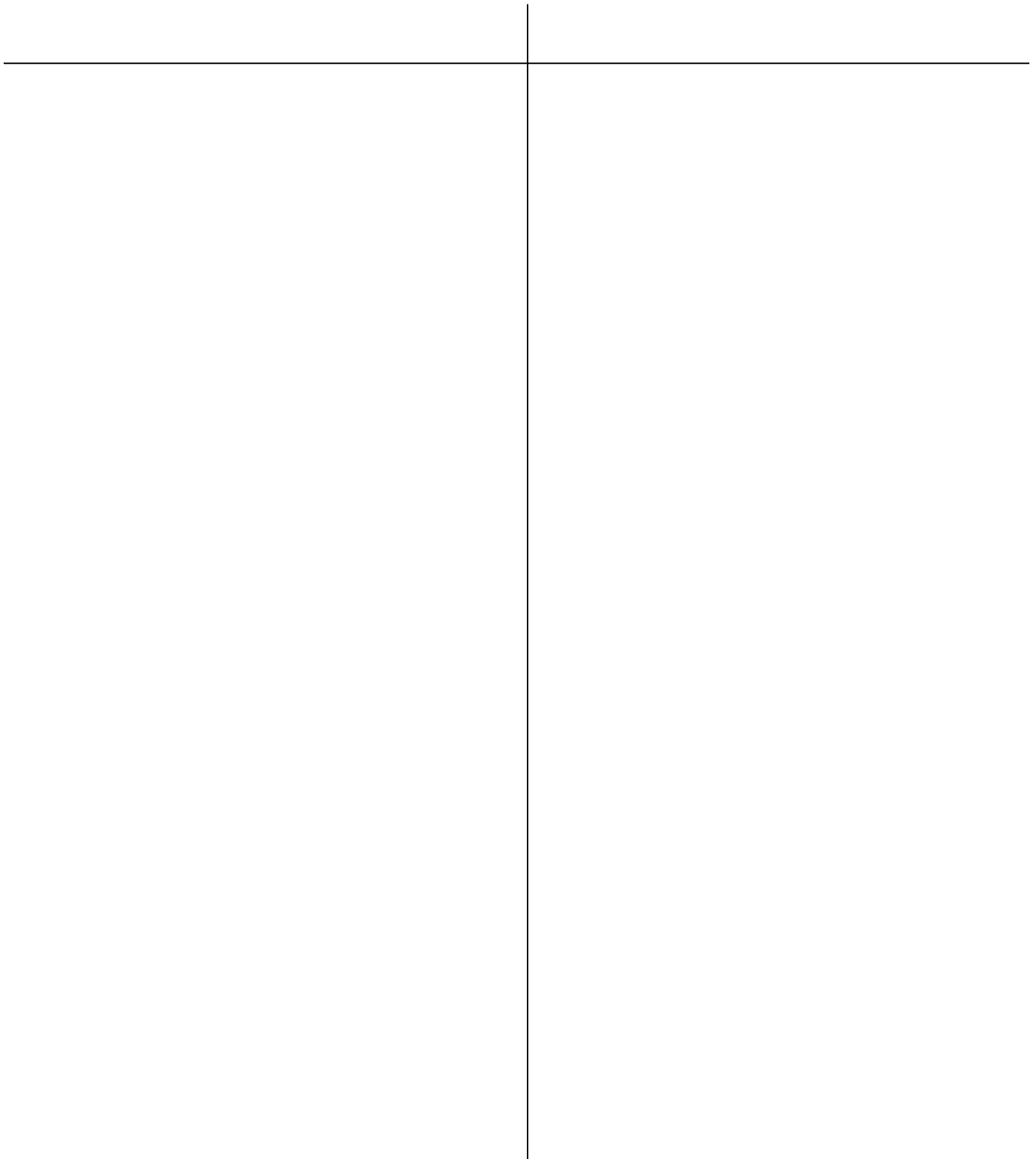

2 Corinthians 6:14-15 Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness?¹⁵ What harmony is there between Christ and Belial? What does a believer have in common with an unbeliever? NIV84

Luke 15:32 “But we had to celebrate and be glad, because this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.” NIV84

Colossians 2:13 When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature, God made you alive with Christ. NIV

Galatians 4:31 Therefore, brothers, we are not children of the slave woman, but of the free woman. NIV84

1 John 3:10 This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are: Anyone who does not do what is right is not a child of God; nor is anyone who does not love his brother. NIV84

Romans 6:17-18 But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you wholeheartedly obeyed the form of teaching to which you were entrusted.¹⁸ You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. NIV84

1 Thessalonians 5:5 You are all sons of the light and sons of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness. NIV84

1 John 2:9 Anyone who claims to be in the light but hates his brother is still in the darkness. NIV84

Acts 26:15-18 “‘I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting,’ the Lord replied.¹⁶ ‘Now get up and stand on your feet. I have appeared to you to appoint you as a servant and as a witness of what you have seen of me and what I will show you.’¹⁷ I will rescue you from your own people and from the Gentiles. I am sending you to them¹⁸ to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.” NIV84

John 3:19-21 [Jesus said,] “This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but men loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.²⁰ Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that his deeds will be exposed.²¹ But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God.” NIV84

2 Timothy 3:1-5 But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days.² People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy,³ without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good,⁴ treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God—⁵ having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with them. NIV84

Lucas 15:32 Pero teníamos que hacer fiesta y alegrarnos, porque este hermano tuyo estaba muerto, pero ahora ha vuelto a la vida; se había perdido, pero ya lo hemos encontrado”»

Colosenses 2:13 Antes de recibir esa circuncisión, ustedes estaban muertos en sus pecados. Sin embargo, Dios nos dio vida en unión con Cristo, al perdonarnos todos los pecados

Gálatas 4:31 Así que, hermanos, no somos hijos de la esclava, sino de la libre.

1 Juan 3:10 Así distinguimos entre los hijos de Dios y los hijos del diablo: el que no practica la justicia no es hijo de Dios; ni tampoco lo es el que no ama a su hermano.

Romanos 6:17-18 Pero gracias a Dios que, aunque antes eran esclavos del pecado, ya se han sometido de corazón a la enseñanza que les fue transmitida. En efecto, habiendo sido liberados del pecado, ahora son ustedes esclavos de la justicia.

1 Tesalonicenses 5:5 Todos ustedes son hijos de la luz y del día. No somos de la noche ni de la oscuridad.

1 Juan 2:9 El que afirma que está en la luz, pero odia a su hermano, todavía está en la oscuridad.

Hechos 26:15-18 Entonces pregunté: “¿Quién eres, Señor?” “Yo soy Jesús, a quien tú persigues —me contestó el Señor—. Ahora, ponte en pie y escúchame. Me he aparecido a ti con el fin de designarte siervo y testigo de lo que has visto de mí y de lo que te voy a revelar. Te libraré de tu propio pueblo y de los gentiles. Te envío a estos para que les abras los ojos y se conviertan de las tinieblas a la luz, y del poder de Satanás a Dios, a fin de que, por la fe en mí, reciban el perdón de los pecados y la herencia entre los santificados”.

Juan 3:19-21 Esta es la causa de la condenación: que la luz vino al mundo, pero la humanidad prefirió las tinieblas a la luz, porque sus hechos eran perversos.²⁰ Pues todo el que hace lo malo aborrece la luz, y no se acerca a ella por temor a que sus obras queden al descubierto.²¹ En cambio, el que practica la verdad se acerca a la luz, para que se vea claramente que ha hecho sus obras en obediencia a Dios».

2 Timoteo 3:1-5 Ahora bien, ten en cuenta que en los últimos días vendrán tiempos difíciles. La gente estará llena de egoísmo y avaricia; serán jactanciosos, arrogantes, blasfemos, desobedientes a los padres, ingratos, impíos, insensibles, implacables, calumniadores, libertinos, despiadados, enemigos de todo lo bueno, traicioneros, impetuosos, vanidosos y más amigos del placer que de Dios. Aparentarán ser piadosos, pero su conducta desmentirá el poder de la piedad. ¡Con esa gente ni te metas!

Colossians 1:21-22 Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior.²² But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation. NIV84

1 Peter 2:10 Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. NIV84

Acts 24:15 I [Paul,] have the same hope in God as these men, that there will be a resurrection of both the righteous and the wicked. NIV84

Mark 2:17 On hearing this, Jesus said to them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." NIV84

Matthew 12:30 [Jesus said,] "He who is not with me is against me, and he who does not gather with me scatters." NIV84

John 9:39 Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, so that the blind will see and those who see will become blind." NIV84

John 5:24 [Jesus said,] "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life." NIV84

Matthew 13:47-50 [Jesus said,] "Once again, the kingdom of heaven is like a net that was let down into the lake and caught all kinds of fish.⁴⁸ When it was full, the fishermen pulled it up on the shore. Then they sat down and collected the good fish in baskets, but threw the bad away.⁴⁹ This is how it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come and separate the wicked from the righteous⁵⁰ and throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." NIV84

Matthew 25:32-33 All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.³³ He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. NIV84

Matthew 25:34-41 "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world.' ...⁴¹ "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.'" NIV84

Colosenses 1:21-22 En otro tiempo ustedes, por su actitud y sus malas acciones, estaban alejados de Dios y eran sus enemigos.²² Pero ahora Dios, a fin de presentarlos santos, intachables e irreprochables delante de él, los ha reconciliado en el cuerpo mortal de Cristo mediante su muerte,

1 Pedro 2:10 Ustedes antes ni siquiera eran pueblo, pero ahora son pueblo de Dios; antes no habían recibido misericordia, pero ahora ya la han recibido.

Hechos 24:15 Tengo en Dios la misma esperanza que estos hombres profesan, de que habrá una resurrección de los justos y de los injustos.

Marcos 2:17 Al oírlos, Jesús les contestó: —No son los sanos los que necesitan médico, sino los enfermos. Y yo no he venido a llamar a justos, sino a pecadores.

Mateo 12:30 »El que no está de mi parte está contra mí; y el que conmigo no recoge, espárce.

Mateo 25:32-33 Todas las naciones se reunirán delante de él, y él separará a unos de otros, como separa el pastor las ovejas de las cabras. Pondrá las ovejas a su derecha, y las cabras a su izquierda.

Mateo 25:34-41 Entonces dirá el Rey a los que estén a su derecha: "Vengan ustedes, a quienes mi Padre ha bendecido; reciban su herencia, el reino preparado para ustedes desde la creación del mundo...⁴¹ »Luego dirá a los que estén a su izquierda: "Apártense de mí, malditos, al fuego eterno preparado para el diablo y sus ángeles.
