Matthew 4:23 Jesus **went** throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people. NIV84

Matthew 9:35 Jesus **went** through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. NIV84

Luke 8:1-3 After this, Jesus **traveled** about from one town and village to another, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God. The Twelve were with him, ² and also some women who had been cured of evil spirits and diseases: Mary (called Magdalene) from whom seven demons had come out; ³ Joanna the wife of Cuza, the manager of Herod's household; Susanna; and many others. These women were helping to support them out of their own means. NIV84

Luke 9:6 So [the twelve] **set out** and **went** from village to village, preaching the gospel and healing people everywhere. NIV84

Luke 10:1 After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and **sent** them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. NIV84

Matthew 22:8-10 "Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding banquet is ready, but those I invited did not deserve to come. ⁹ **Go** to the street corners and invite to the banquet anyone you find.' ¹⁰ So the servants went out into the streets and gathered all the people they could find, both good and bad, and the wedding hall was filled with guests." NIV84

John 20:21 Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am **sending** you. NIV84

Matthew 28:18-20 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore **go** and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." NIV84

Acts 1:8 [Jesus said,] "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." NIV84

Acts 5:42 Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Christ. NIV84

Acts 22:21 "Then the Lord said to [Paul], 'Go; I will **send** you far away to the Gentiles.'" NIV84

Acts 20:20-21 You know that I [, Paul,] have not hesitated to preach anything that would be helpful to you but have taught you publicly and from house to house. ²¹ I have declared to both Jews and Greeks that they must turn to God in repentance and have faith in our Lord Jesus. NIV84
